House prepares to address the nation Wednesday about his new approach for the war, which includes an increase of up to 20,000 additional U.S. troops, Allard said.

Democratic leaders in Congress — and some Republicans — have criticized Bush's plan already, saying they want a drawdown of troops, not an increase in U.S. forces.

But Allard said there's more to Bush's plan than more troops. The Iraqis also would take on greater responsibility for security in the nation, which is increas-

ingly plagued by sectarian violence, he said.

"It's a significantly different plan," Allard said. He did not know how long the added U.S. forces would be needed. "Nobody's talking about specific dates," he said.

Colorado's Democratic Sen. Ken Salazar, who was not in the meeting, has said he wants to hear more from Bush before giving his opinion.

"We need a new direction in Iraq, and I am hopeful the nation can come together in the weeks ahead to address this

critical national security issue," Salazar said in a statement.

Allard said U.S. security and help in Iraq has become "kind of like welfare. They get addicted to it and don't do their share."

In the new plan, the president has made it clear that Iraqis need to take control of the country — despite the increase in troops, Allard said.

"I think we need to have extra troops there," he said. "I'm willing with this new plan to give them another shot. The cost of failure is too great."
